

Two fixed-term Positions: one Professor and one Associate Professor in EFL at Nagoya University, Japan

The Graduate School of Languages and Cultures at Nagoya University invites applications for two non-renewable, three-year positions: one professor and one associate professor in the field of English as a Foreign Language. The appointments will commence on April 1, 2007.

1. Applicants for these positions should:
 - a) be a native speaker of English,
 - b) be under 60 years of age as of April 1, 2007
 - c) have a professional interest in teaching English as a foreign language, and
 - d) hold a master's or higher degree in a relevant field.
2. Each successful candidate will be appointed as an associate or full professor for three years only, and the appointment cannot be renewed.
3. Holders of each post will be required to teach seven 90-minute classes per week and to participate in preparing and marking the foreign-language component of the Nagoya University Entrance Examinations.
4. Remuneration will be approximately five to nine million yen per annum (including bonuses) before tax depending on age, qualifications, and experience. Successful applicants from overseas will have the cost of their airfare to Japan reimbursed by the university.
5. For consideration, applicants are requested to submit the following:
 - a) a letter of interest, explaining professional suitability and intentions if hired,
 - b) a curriculum vitae (including date of birth),
 - c) a recent photograph,
 - d) a list of publications,
 - e) copies of three published works and their abstracts, and
 - f) two personal letters of reference written within the last six months.

7. Final candidates will be asked to provide a health certificate, so please be prepared to submit one at short notice.
8. Final decisions will be made following personal interviews, which may be conducted by telephone in the case of applicants overseas.
